Evaluate

What, where, when, why, how and who? Writing the Project Brief. Establishing the basis for change control and getting agreement/buy in from all stakeholders. Establishing high-level estimates.

Plan

Building the Project Charter: Objectives, Scope, Milestones, Schedule, Project Organisation, Documentation, Risk, Change Control, Approval. Refine estimates, allocate work. Risk assessment and contingency planning; managing change.
